




Arts-Based Research (ABR) Samples *Concealed reveal,* 2018, Mixed media on canvas, 7x5 in.




Arts-Based Research (ABR) Samples *An "I" poem,* 2018, Mixed media on canvas, 12x12 in.














These Places Thus Far, 2016-2023, Mixed media on canvas, 8 x 10 in.
